Chapter 182.

Resolve in favor of Benjamin F. Colcord.

Benjamin F. Colcord, in favor of. Resolved, That the sum of forty-two dollars and fifty cents be appropriated and paid to Benjamin F. Colcord to defray expenses incurred by the committee appointed to attend the funeral of Charles T. Randall.

Approved March 27, 1907.

Chapter 183.

Resolve in favor of Harry P. Hawes.

Harry P. Hawes, in favor of. Resolved, That there be appropriated and paid to Harry P. Hawes for services as clerk to the committee on interior waters and to the committee on ways and bridges, and for services of typewriter and messenger to same committees, the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars.

Approved March 27, 1907.

Chapter 184.

Resolve in favor of Secretary of Committee on Banks and Banking.

T. W. Baldwin, in favor of, Resolved, That the sum of fifty dollars be paid to T. W. Baldwin for expenses of messenger for committee on banks and banking during the session.

Approved March 27, 1907.

Chapter 185.

Resolve in favor of Senate Postmaster.

Senate postmaster, in favor of. Resolved, That the senate postmaster receive the same sum for expenses as that received by the postmaster of the senate at the last session of the legislature.
