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**Chapter 186.**

Resolve for the re-arrangement and better preservation of the Flags in the cases in the Rotunda.

*Resolved,* That the superintendent of buildings shall, under the direction of the governor and council, cause the flags now in the cases in the rotunda of this building to be re-arranged, looking to their better preservation, having them rolled on their staffs or otherwise furled, maintaining so far as possible the same general arrangement in the cases as now, and shall cause the cases containing said flags to be made as nearly air-tight as possible. The expense of the same to be paid from any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

For better preservation and re-arrangement of flags in state house.

Approved March 27, 1907.

**Chapter 187.**

Resolve in favor of Rose Kelley.

*Resolved,* That there be paid out of the state treasury to Rose Kelley of Bangor in the county of Penobscot a pension of four dollars per month, beginning on the first day of January, nineteen hundred seven, and to continue during the pleasure of the legislature.

**Chapter 188.**

Resolve in favor of the Clerk in the office of the Commissioner of Highways.

*Resolved,* That the sum of three hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and seven for the purpose of raising his salary from one thousand dollars to one thousand three hundred dollars as contemplated by the committee on state lands and state roads.

Clerk to commissioner of highways, in favor of.
