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**Chapter 197.**

*Resolved*, That the sum of forty-five dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of reimbursing the town of Gray for money paid on account of Willis Anderson, a state pauper.

Be it further resolved, That the sum of twelve dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of reimbursing the town of Gray for money paid on account of Grover C. Borborick, a state pauper.

Be it further resolved, That the sum of eighty-five dollars and fifty-nine cents be and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of reimbursing the town of Gray for money paid on account of Herbert M. Verrill of Riley plantation, a state pauper.
