Chapter 200.

Resolves authorizing a Temporary Loan for the year nineteen hundred and seven.

Resolved, That to provide for the wants of the treasury, the treasurer of state be and is hereby authorized to procure on the faith of the state, if he shall deem it necessary, at any time during the year nineteen hundred and seven, a temporary loan of three hundred thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be needed.

Chapter 202.

Resolves authorizing a Temporary Loan for the year nineteen hundred and eight.

Resolved, That to provide for the wants of the treasury, the treasurer of state be and is hereby authorized to procure on the faith of the state, if he shall deem it necessary, at any time during the year nineteen hundred and eight, a temporary loan of three hundred thousand dollars or so much thereof as may be needed.
