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CHAP. 222

Counsel for both parties shall present an account for their services and expenses, and also shall certify the names of witnesses and officers and the amounts due each, the same to be presented to the governor and council, who shall audit the same and draw a warrant for payment thereof upon the treasurer of the state.

Resolve in favor of C. W. Perry, Secretary to Committee on Mercantile Affairs and Insurance.

in favor of. *Resolved,* That the sum of thirty-five dollars be paid C. W. Perry for services of clerk and typewriter to the committee on mercantile affairs and insurance.

**Chapter 223.**

Resolve in favor of H. M. Sewall, chairman of Committee on gubernatorial Votes.

H. M. Sewall,  
in favor of. *Resolved,* That there be appropriated and paid to H. M. Sewall, chairman of the committee on gubernatorial votes, the sum of twelve dollars, for disbursements made for expenses in canvassing the votes returned for governor.

**Chapter 224.**

Resolve in favor of Clerk and Stenographer to the Joint Special Committee on Salaries and Fees.

W. S. Cotton,  
in favor of. *Resolved,* That there be appropriated and paid to W. S. Cotton one hundred sixty-three dollars and sixteen cents for services as clerk to the joint special committee on salaries and fees. Also for stenographer to said committee.
