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CHAP. 229

**Chapter 229.**

Resolve relating to Financial Statement prepared by order of the Legislature.

Compiling and printing financial statement, to provide for expense of.

*Resolved,* To provide for the expense of compiling and supervising the printing of the financial statement prepared by the committee on appropriations and financial affairs by order of the legislature the sum of one hundred dollars is hereby appropriated.

**Chapter 230.**

Resolve to reimburse the State Treasurer for expense of Surety Bond.

Surety bond, to reimburse state treasurer for.

*Resolved,* That the sum of three hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated for the year one thousand nine hundred and seven, and three hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated for the year one thousand nine hundred and eight, to be paid to the state treasurer to reimburse him for sum paid by him as premium on his surety bond, given in pursuance of the constitution and laws of the state.

**Chapter 231.**

Resolve laying a Tax on the Counties of the State for the years nineteen hundred and seven and nineteen hundred and eight.

County tax for 1907 and 1908.

*Resolved,* That the sum annexed to the counties in the following schedule is hereby granted as a tax on each county respectively to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied to the purposes of paying the debts and necessary expenses of the same and for other purposes of law.
