Resolve in favor of the clerk and stenographer to the Committee on State Lands and State Roads.

*Resolved,* That there be appropriated and paid to Frank C. Cobb the sum of forty dollars for services as clerk to the committee on state lands and state roads and that there be appropriated and paid to Annie P. Bibber the sum of fifty dollars for services as stenographer and typewriter to the same committee.

**Chapter 240.**

Resolve, in favor of the clerk to the committee on Telegraphs and Telephones and State prison.

*Resolved,* That the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars be paid to Chapin Lydston for services as clerk to the committee on telegraphs and telephones and state prison.

**Chapter 241.**

Resolve in relation to money credited to Dallas Plantation in error.

*Resolved,* That the state treasurer be and hereby is authorized to charge to Dallas plantation, the sum of eight hundred nine dollars and three cents credited to said plantation on November thirtieth, nineteen hundred and five, by land agent.
