Chapter 1.

An Act to authorize the Governor to appoint a Stenographer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The Governor may appoint some suitable person as his stenographer, who shall hold the position during the pleasure of the Governor, and shall receive in full compensation for such services the sum of one thousand dollars per annum, from January one, nineteen hundred and nine.
