Chapter 68.

Resolve in favor of an appropriation for a Breakwater in Moosehead Lake

Resolved, that the sum of one thousand dollars be, and is hereby appropriated to extend the breakwater in Moosehead lake from the point where it now terminates into said lake, so as to protect the harbor at Kineo Point; and that said money be expended under the direction of the county commissioners of Piscataquis county with the advice of the governor and council, provided that the Kineo Company shall expend for said purpose at least twelve hundred dollars.

Resolve in favor of Joseph A. Mitchell, representative of Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians.

Resolved, that the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars be and hereby is appropriated to pay representative of the Passamaquoddy tribe of Indians for his travel and attendance at this session of the legislature. This resolve facilitates the performance of the business of this legislature.

Chapter 71.

Resolve in favor of the Webber Hospital Association of Biddeford.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of three thousand dollars to be paid to the Webber Hospital Association of Biddeford, York county, Maine, for the use of said association for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and three thousand for the use of said association for the year nineteen hundred and ten, both said sums for maintenance.

Chapter 73.

Resolve. Providing for the Payment of Claims, Accounts and Demands against the State, Accrued Prior to January one, nineteen hundred and nine, and Remaining Unpaid by Reason of Insufficient Appropriations.

Preamble.

Whereas the various deficiency items comprised in this resolve are long overdue and further delay in the payment thereof will occasion great inconvenience to many departments of the state government and citizens of the state; and whereas in the opinion of this legislature these facts constitute this resolve an emergency measure, which is immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, now therefore be it

Resolved, that for the purpose of paying the several claims, accounts and demands against the state, accrued prior to, and remaining unpaid on January first, nineteen hundred and nine, by reason of insufficient appropriations, as reported to the legislature, by communication from the state auditor under date of January fifteenth, nineteen hundred and nine, in compliance with section five of chapter one hundred and forty-seven, of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seven, there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of one hundred two thousand, eight hundred seventy-four dollars, eighty-one cents, to be paid the several persons, firms and corporations named in said communication, respectively, the amounts therein reported, as follows:
