CHAP. 73

Trustees Insane Hospitals, Deficiency nineteen hundred and seven, seven hundred thirty-two dollars, ninety-nine cents,	732 99
Visiting Committee State School for Boys, Deficiency nineteen hundred and seven, twenty dollars	20 00

Amounting to the sum of one hundred two thousand, eight hundred seventy-four dollars, eighty-one cents \$102,874 81

In view of the emergency set forth in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 74.

Resolve for the purpose of erecting a fish hatchery in Knox County.

Fish hatchery, Knox County, for the erection of.

Resolved, that the sum of three thousand dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten, for the purpose of erecting a suitable fish hatchery for the artificial propagation of fish and restocking the waters of Knox county and vicinity, the same to be erected at some point in said Knox county to be hereafter determined by the commissioners on inland fisheries and game, the same to be expended by the commissioners of inland fisheries and game.

Chapter 75.

Resolve in favor of the Children's Protective Society of Portland.

Children's Protective Society of Portland, in favor of.

Resolve, that the sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred nine and five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred ten be and hereby is appropriated to be paid the Children's Protective Society of Portland, to assist the said society in its work in the protection and care of dependent and neglected children.
