Chapter 76.

Resolve in favor of the hospital of the Daughters of Wisdom of the town of Saint Agatha, Maine.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and the sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten, to be paid the hospital of the Daughters of Wisdom of Saint Agatha for the maintenance of said institution: also the further sum of two thousand dollars to be paid the said hospital in the year nineteen hundred nine for the purpose of enlarging and completing its building.

Chapter 77.

Resolve in favor of the Maine School for the Deaf.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated to be paid the Maine School for the Deaf the sum of seventeen thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred nine, and the sum of seventeen thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred ten, both said sums for maintenance; also the further sum of twelve thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred nine for the purpose of completing payment on new school building and equipping the school for manual training and other industries.

Chapter 78.

Resolve in favor of John M. Taylor.

Resolved, that the sum of one hundred ninety-two dollars be and hereby is appropriated to be paid John M. Taylor of Cape Elizabeth for expense of clerk hire incurred by him in performance of his duties as state inspector of steam vessels during the years nineteen hundred seven and nineteen hundred eight.
