STARKS-J. E JEWETT-BUOYS RICHARDSON LAKE-MT. CHASE.

Chapter 119.

Resolve in favor of the Town of Starks.

Resolved, that the sum of one hundred seventy-five dollars and seventy cents be, and is hereby appropriated to the town of favor of. Starks to reimburse said town for a state tax of one hundred twenty-one dollars and twenty-six cents and a county tax of fifty-four dollars and forty-four cents paid by said town of Starks on that portion of said town set off from the town of Starks on to the town of Norridgewock in nineteen hundred and seven.

Chapter 120.

Resolve in favor of Joseph E. Jewett.

Resolved, that there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of Joseph E. twelve dollars and twenty cents to be paid to Joseph E. Jewett favor of Vassalboro, the amount due said Jewett on account of conveying one Harvey Wentworth to the State School for Boys.

Chapter 121.

Resolve in favor of buoys on Richardson Lake.

Resolved, that the sum of two hundred fifty dollars is hereby Richardappropriated to be expended under the direction of the state in aid of steamboat inspectors in placing buoys at such points in Rich- navigasteamboat inspectors in placing buoys at such points in Rich- tion on. ardson Lake as will best serve the needs of navigation thereon.

Chapter 122.

Resolve in favor of the town of Mount Chase in Penobscot County.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum Town of of one hundred and fifty dollars to aid in repairing two miles of road and a bridge constituting a part thereof, said two miles of road to be the first two miles east of the west line of the town of Mount Chase to the town of Patten; the same to be expended by the highway commissioner of the town of Mount Chase, under the direction of an agent to be appointed for that purpose by the governor and council.
