### Chapter 157.

Resolve in favor of the Maine Insane Hospital, for additional compensation for certain officers.

Maine Insane Hospital, additional pay for certain officers. Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of two thousand one hundred dollars annually for the years nineteen hundred and nine and nineteen hundred and ten, for additional compensation for physicians, internes and chaplains, at the Maine Insane Hospital, to be apportioned by the trustees of said institution.

Approved March 16, 1909.

#### Chapter 158.

Resolve in favor of Wilton Academy.

Wilton Academy, in favor of. Resolved, that there be appropriated for the use of the trustees of Wilton Academy the sum of seven thousand and five hundred dollars for the purpose of repairing and remodelling the present school building and for installing a heating plant.

Approved March 16, 1909.

### Chapter 159.

Resolve in favor of aiding the building of a Bridge across the Fish River.

Bridge across Fish River, in aid of. Resolved, that there be, and hereby is appropriated the sum of four thousand dollars to aid in the erection and construction of a bridge across Fish River at Soldier Pond, in Wallagrass plantation, and the same to be expended under the direction of some person appointed by the governor and council.
