Resolve in favor of the town of Dover.

Resolved, that the sum of sixty-six dollars and thirty-three cents be, and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of reimbursing the town of Dover for money paid on account of Mrs. Joseph A. Tardiff, a state pauper.
