Chapter 266.

Resolve in favor of Navigation on Lewy, Long and Big Lakes.

Navigation on Lewy, Long and Big Lakes, in favor of. Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars, for buoys and replacing buoys to be laid out under the steamboat inspectors direction.

Approved March 29, 1909,

Chapter 267.

Resolve laying a tax on the Counties of the State for the years nineteen hundred and nine and nineteen hundred and ten.

County Tax for 1909 and 1910. Whereas, the appropriations called for in this resolve are immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health and safety, and in the opinion of this legislature constitutes an emergency as contemplated by the constitution, be it therefore

Resolved, that the sum annexed to the counties in the following schedule is hereby granted as a tax on each county respectively to be appropriated, assessed, collected and applied to the purpose of paying the debts and necessary expenses of the same and for other purposes of law. For the year one thousand nine hundred and nine.
