Chapter 304.

Resolve in favor of screening China Lake, in Kennebec County.

Resolved, that the sum of two hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and two hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten, be and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of erecting a screen at the outlet of China lake, in Kennebec county, to be paid from the appropriation for the operation of the fish hatcheries and feeding stations for fish and for the protection of fish, to be expended under the direction of the commissioners of inland fisheries and game.

Provided, however, that this appropriation shall not be available until the town of Vassalboro shall have, in legal town meeting, and having an article in the warrant for said town meeting for that purpose, by vote of record, voted to assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same.

Proviso.

Provided, further, that the amount above appropriated shall not be available until the balance necessary to erect said screen, as found by the commissioners, shall have been raised by the inhabitants of the county of Kennebec, and paid into the treasurer of state for this purpose.

Chapter 305.

Resolve in favor of a screen at the outlet of Squa Pan Lake, in Aroostook County.

Resolved, that the sum of four hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and ten, to be paid out of the appropriation for fish hatcheries and feeding stations for fish and for the protection of fish, for the purpose of erecting a screen at the outlet of Squa Pan lake, in Aroostook county, to be expended under the direction of the commissioners of inland fisheries and game, when the balance necessary to erect said screen, as found by the commissioners, shall have been raised by the inhabitants of the county of Aroostook, and paid into the treasurer of state for this purpose.

Provided, further, that this appropriation shall not be available until the town of Presque Isle shall have, in legal town meeting, and having an article in the warrant for said town
