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And whereas, by reason of the foregoing facts the appropriation called for in this resolve is exceedingly necessary for the purpose of the public health and safety, and in the opinion of this legislature constitutes an emergency, as contemplated by the constitution.

Resolved, that the sum of ten thousand dollars is hereby appropriated, to be taken from the general appropriation heretofore made by this legislature for the operation of fish hatcheries and feeding stations, to be expended by the commissioners of inland fisheries and game, under the direction of the governor and council. In view of the facts recited in the preamble, this resolve, two thirds of all the members elected to each house having so directed, shall take effect when approved.
