Chapter 343.

Resolve to amend Chapter one hundred and twenty-six of the Resolves of nineteen hundred and five, as amended by Chapter seventy-nine of the Resolves of nineteen hundred and seven, relating to the Central Maine Fair Association.

Resolved, that chapter one hundred and twenty-six of the resolves of nineteen hundred and five, as amended by chapter seventy-nine of the resolves of nineteen hundred and seven, be and is hereby amended by striking out all after the word "amount" in the fourth line, and substituting in place thereof the following: 'Said society may draw said appropriation upon its voucher that such amount has been paid out for strictly agricultural and dairy purposes;' so that said chapter as amended shall read as follows:

'Resolved, that the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated annually for the Central Maine Fair Association, provided that the above named society shall annually appropriate an equal amount to be paid in premiums for stock, dairy and agricultural products. Said society may draw said appropriation upon its voucher that such amount has been paid out for strictly agricultural and dairy purposes.'
