Chapter 1.

An Act to change the name of Horse Island and the name of Horse Island Harbor,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The name of Horse Island, located in Casco bay, in the town of Phippsburg, is hereby changed and shall hereafter be known and designated as Harbor Island.

Name of Horse Island changed.

Section 2. The name of Horse Island Harbor, in Casco Bay, in the town of Phippsburg, is hereby changed and shall hereafter be known and designated as Sebasco Harbor.

Name of Horse Island Harbor changed.
