person or corporation, otherwise such person or corporation shall recover such costs against said company.

Section 4. Said Eastport Water Company shall be held Linble for damages oc-casioned by liable to pay all damages that shall be sustained by any person by the taking of any land or other property, or by flowage, etc. or by excavating through any land for the purposes of this act, and also damages for any other injuries resulting from said acts; and if any person sustaining damages as aforesaid and said corporation cannot mutually agree upon the sum to be tained, if paid therefor such person may cause his damages to be ascer- not agree. tained in the manner and under the same conditions, restrictions and limitations as are by law prescribed in the case of damages, by the laying out of railroads; except that damages -exception. for flowage shall be ascertained in accordance with the provisions of chapter ninety-four of the revised statutes of Maine.

Chapter 133.

An Act to protect striped or sea bass, in the waters of the Sheepscot River and its tributaries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. It shall be unlawful to fish for or catch striped close time on or sea bass in the waters of the Sheepscot river and its tributaries in any manner except by hook and line, between Febrnary fifteen and December thirty-one in each year.

Section 2. Any person convicted of fishing or catching Penalty. striped or sea bass contrary to the provisions of section one of this act shall be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than twenty-five dollars, by complaint or indictment. One-half to the use of the complainant and one-half to the county. Full jurisdiction to impose such fine is hereby conferred upon trial justices.
