As Passed by the Seventy-fifth Legislature

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#### Chapter 161.

Снар. 161

An Act to prevent the destruction of Smelts in the waters of the Towns of Lubec and Trescott in the County of Washington.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter two hundred and fifty-one of the pri-vate and special laws of nineteen hundred and three is hereby special laws amended by inserting a period in the place of a comma after amended. the word "seines" in the third line thereof and striking out all the rest of said section after said word and inserting the following words: 'Smelts shall not be taken in any manner in the waters of the towns aforesaid between the first day of March and the first day of September in each year. No weir for the catching of smelts in said towns shall be constructed with less than two feet of water at extreme low tide.' So that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'All persons are hereby prohibited from taking smelts in the -smelt fishwaters of the towns of Lubec and Trescott in the county of ing in waters of Lubec and Washington, by means of purse or drag seines. Smelts shall Tregulated. not be taken in any manner in the waters of the towns aforesaid between the first day of March and the first day of September in each year. No weir for the catching of smelts in said towns shall be constructed with less than two feet of water at extreme low tide.'

Approved March 22, 1911.

#### Chapter 162.

An Act to amend An Act authorizing the Penobscot Chemical Fibre Company to generate, use, transmit and sell electricity.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section one of chapter two hundred and eighty-seven of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and seven, entitled:

An Act to amend section one of chapter one hundred forty- certain acts three of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and five, entitled An Act to amend section one of chapter eightynine of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and three, entitled "An Act to authorize the Penobscot Chemical Fibre Company to make, generate, use, transmit and sell electricity", is hereby amended by inserting after the word "Bradley" in the fourth, twenty-second and thirty-third lines the words 'and between the towns of Orono and Bradley' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:
