CHAP. 297**Chapter 297.**

An Act authorizing the State Land Agent to sell certain property of the State at the Belgrade Fish Hatchery, in the County of Kennebec.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sale of farm
by state land
agent author-
ized.

The state land agent is hereby authorized to sell, under the direction of the governor and council, at public auction, to the highest bidder, after advertising, the farm at the Belgrade fish hatchery, the proceeds of said sale to be paid to the state treasurer.

Chapter 298.

An Act to provide for the restoration of the records of the Court of Probate for the County of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter 85,
special laws,
1909,
amended.

Chapter eighty-five of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and nine is hereby amended by striking out in the fourth line of section twenty of said chapter the word "three," and substituting therefor the word 'five.'

Chapter 299.

An Act to appropriate moneys for the Expenditures of Government for the year one thousand nine hundred and eleven.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. In order to provide for the several acts and resolves of the legislature requiring the payment of money from the state treasury, and also to provide in part for the necessary expenditures of government for the current fiscal year one thousand nine hundred and eleven, the following sums are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury, and, except where otherwise specially provided, the governor with the advice and consent of the council, is hereby authorized at any time prior to the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and twelve, to draw his warrant on the state treasurer for the same.
