Chapter 1.

Resolve, authorizing a Temporary Loan for the year nineteen hundred and eleven.

Whereas, it is necessary to provide for the wants of the treasury, that the treasurer of the state be authorized to procure on the faith of the state, a temporary loan of three hundred thousand dollars, and

Preamble.

Whereas, in the opinion of the legislature this fact renders the immediate passage of this resolve necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and constitutes an emergency within the meaning of the constitution, now therefore, be

Emergency.

Resolved, that to provide for the wants of the treasury, the treasurer of state be and hereby is authorized to procure on the faith of the state, at any time during the year nineteen hundred and eleven, a temporary loan of three hundred thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be needed.

Temporary loan, authorized.

Resolved, that the treasurer of state be and hereby is authorized to give notes in behalf of the state, payable within two years from the date hereof, for such portions of the loan hereby authorized as may be required.

State Treasurer may give notes for.

Resolved, that this resolve shall take effect when approved.
