Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated to the Old Town Hospital the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for maintenance and sewer connection for the year nineteen hundred and eleven and the sum of one thousand dollars for maintenance for the year nineteen hundred and twelve. The same to be paid to the treasurer of said institution.

**Chapter 49.**

Resolve in favor of the Maine Eye and Ear Infirmary.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated annually the sum of three thousand five hundred dollars to be paid to the treasurer of the Maine Eye and Ear Infirmary for the use of the institution for the years nineteen hundred and eleven and nineteen hundred and twelve for maintenance.
