CHAP. 56**Chapter 56.**

Resolve in favor of the York Hospital.

York Hospital, in favor of.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated for the York Hospital the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eleven, and one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twelve for maintenance.

Chapter 57.

Resolve in favor of Knox County General Hospital.

Knox County General Hospital, in favor of.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars to be paid to the Knox County General Hospital for the year nineteen hundred and eleven, and two thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twelve, both said sums for maintenance.

Chapter 58.

Resolve in favor of Frank W. Burnham.

Frank W. Burnham, in favor of.

Resolved, that the sum of three hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to Frank W. Burnham for the expenses incurred by him in the seventy-fifth legislature of Maine, in contesting the seat of Fred A. Chandler of Washington county in the senate.

Resolve in favor of Fred A. Chandler.

Resolved, that the sum of three hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to Fred A. Chandler for the expenses incurred by him in the seventy-fifth legislature of Maine, in connection with the contest for election of Frank W. Burnham of Washington county in the senate.
