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RESOLVES

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CHAP. 61 Department of Agriculture shall issue circular, giving conditions of award. the

And be it further resolved; that, before the month of January next following the season upon which the award is made, the department of agriculture shall mail to the postmaster of each town in the state, to be posted in the post office, a circular giving the conditions of the award, which, in addition to those already prescribed, shall provide that the trees planted may be from any one or more of four standard varieties of trees, the Ben Davis alone excluded.

And be it further resolved; that, if in the future, it shall be deemed by the department of agriculture inexpedient to continue offering the premiums, the entire amount of interest, as it falls due shall be collected by said treasurer and forthwith paid to the University of Maine to be devoted to the aid of poor and deserving students therein.

Chapter 61.

Resolve in favor of the Good Samaritan Home Association of Bangor.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of twelve hundred dollars to be paid to the Good Samaritan Home Association of Bangor for the use of said institution for the year nineteen hundred and eleven, and twelve hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred twelve, for maintenance.
