Chapter 63.

CHAP. 63

Resolve in favor of the Androscoggin Anti-Tuberculosis Association.

Resolved, that the sum of five hundred dollars be, and hereby is appropriated to be paid to the Androscoggin Anti-Tuberculosis Association for the year nineteen hundred and eleven and five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twelve to be used in the charitable work of said association.

Androscoggin Anti-Tuberculosis Association, in favor of.

Chapter 64.

Resolve in favor of the Bath Military and Naval Orphan Asylum.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated for the Bath Military and Naval Orphan Asylum the sum of nine thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eleven and eight thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twelve for maintenance of said asylum.

Chapter 65.

Resolve in favor of St. Elizabeth's Roman Catholic Asylum of Portland.

Resolved, that there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of four thousand dollars to be paid to the St. Elizabeth Roman Catholic Asylum of Portland, for the use of the said institution; two thousand dollars to be appropriated for the use of said institution for the year nineteen hundred and eleven, and two thousand dollars to be appropriated for the use of the said institution for the year nineteen hundred and twelve, for maintenance.
