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**Chapter 69.**

Resolve in favor of the Maine School for the Deaf.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated to be paid the Maine School for the Deaf the sum of twenty-two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eleven, and the sum of twenty-two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twelve, both said sums for maintenance and running expenses.

Maine School for Deaf, in favor of.

**Chapter 70.**

Resolve authorizing a Temporary Loan for the year nineteen hundred and twelve.

Resolved, that to provide for the wants of the treasury, the treasurer of state be and is hereby authorized to procure on the faith of the state, if he shall deem it necessary, at any time during the year nineteen hundred and twelve, a temporary loan of three hundred thousand dollars or so much thereof as may be needed.

Temporary loan for 1912 authorized.

Resolved, that the treasurer of state be and hereby is authorized to give notes in behalf of the state, payable within three years from the date hereof, for such portions of the loan hereby authorized as may be required.

State treasurer may give notes.

Resolved, that in pursuance of this resolve and of a former resolve passed by this legislature authorizing a like loan for the year nineteen hundred and eleven, the treasurer of state is authorized, from time to time, as may be necessary and advisable to renew said loans and to sign renewal notes for the same.

Loans may be renewed.

Approved March 17, 1911.

**Chapter 71.**

Resolve in favor of Charles A. Rolfe.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated out of any funds in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of five hundred and eighty-six dollars and fifty-seven cents to be paid to Charles A. Rolfe, agent for the Passamaquoddy Indians, for May and November dividends, nineteen hundred and ten, and expenses in connection therewith.
