Resolved, that there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of four thousand dollars to be paid to the Augusta General Hospital for the use of said institution for the year nineteen hundred and eleven and four thousand dollars for the use of said institution for the year nineteen hundred and twelve, for maintenance.

Chapter 79.

Resolve in favor of the Children's Aid Society of Maine, located at Belfast.

Resolved, that the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eleven, and fifteen hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twelve be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to the Children's Aid Society of Maine to aid in maintaining the Home for Friendless and Destitute Girls, at Belfast.

Approved March 17, 1911.

Chapter 80.

Resolve in favor of the Maine General Hospital.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of nine thousand dollars to be paid to the Maine General Hospital, for the use of said institution for the year nineteen hundred and eleven, and nine thousand dollars, to be paid to said institution for its use for the year nineteen hundred and twelve, both said sums for maintenance.

Resolve in favor of the Maine Home for Friendless Boys.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated for the use of the Maine Home for Friendless Boys the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eleven and fifteen hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twelve, both said sums for maintenance.
