Chapter 103.

Resolve for the preservation of the Regimental Rolls in office of Adjutant General.

Resolved, that the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eleven and two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twelve, be and are hereby appropriated for the preservation of the regimental rolls in the office of the adjutant general, said sum to be expended under the direction of the adjutant general.

Chapter 104.

Resolve in favor of the Maine State Prison.

Resolved, that the sum of five hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated for and in behalf of the Maine State prison for the year nineteen hundred and eleven, and a like sum for the year nineteen hundred and twelve. The same to be expended under the direction and supervision of the governor and council for such expenses as they may deem expedient.

Chapter 105.

Resolve providing for an appropriation for the protection of trees and shrubs from the introduction and ravages of dangerous insects and diseases for the year nineteen hundred and twelve.

Resolved, that for the purpose of carrying into effect all provisions of the law now in force, or as the same may be amended and added to, relative to the protection of trees and shrubs from the introduction and ravages of the gypsy moths, there is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury the sum of fifteen thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and twelve.
