**CHAP. 137****Chapter 137.**

Resolve in favor of M. P. Colbath, of Seboomook, Maine.

M. P. Colbath, in favor of.

Resolved, that the sum of forty-nine dollars is hereby appropriated to be paid to M. P. Colbath, of Seboomook, to reimburse said Colbath for money paid out and services performed while acting as forest fire warden in the year nineteen hundred and eight.

Approved March 29, 1911.

**Chapter 138.**

Resolve in favor of John Holden and Company.

John Holden and Co. in favor of.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of one hundred and thirty-two dollars and fifty-seven cents to be paid to John Holden and Company for supplies furnished fire wardens, and cash paid men for fighting forest fires in the fall of nineteen hundred and eight.

Approved March 29, 1911.

**Chapter 139.**

Resolve in favor of Freeman B. Andrews of Oxford for an increase in pension.

Freeman B. Andrews, in favor of.

Resolved, that the sum of eight dollars per month be and hereby is appropriated as a pension for Freeman B. Andrews of Oxford in the county of Oxford, a soldier of the civil war, to be paid to him quarterly out of any moneys available for that purpose in the treasury of the state; the same to be paid in lieu of six dollars per month now being paid to him under resolve passed by the legislature of nineteen hundred and nine.

**Chapter 140.**

Resolve in favor of Maine Industrial School for Girls for permanent improvements and general repairs.

Maine Industrial School, in favor of.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and eleven the sum of twenty-three hundred dollars for the Maine Industrial School for Girls, the same to be expended by and under the direction of the board of trustees of said school for permanent improvements and general repairs at the school.
