Chapter 141.

Resolve in favor of navigation on Sebec Lake.

Resolved, that the sum of one hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys and maintenance of lights and buoys in Sebec lake for the year nineteen hundred and eleven; and the sum of one hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys and maintenance of lights and buoys for the year nineteen hundred and twelve. All said money shall be expended under the direction of the state steamboat inspectors, and any part of the money hereby appropriated which shall be unexpended at the end of the year of nineteen hundred and twelve shall revert to the state.

Chapter 142.

Resolve in favor of the Maine State Sanatorium Association.

Resolved, that there be and is hereby appropriated to be paid to the Maine State Sanatorium Association for the year nineteen hundred and eleven the sum of twelve thousand five hundred dollars, and a like sum for the year nineteen hundred and twelve, for assistance to needy patients, to be used in the discretion of the trustees of said association, subject to the approval of the governor and council, for charitable purposes in the treatment of patients at said institution.

Chapter 143.

Resolve in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls, for water supply.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and eleven for the Maine Industrial School for Girls, the same to be expended by and under the direction of the board of trustees of said school for the water supply.
