CHAP. 153**Chapter 153.**

Resolve in favor of Maine Industrial School for Girls for maintenance and deficiency.

Resolved, that there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of twenty-three thousand dollars for the Maine Industrial School for Girls for maintenance for nineteen hundred and eleven. Same to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of said school.

Maine Industrial School for Girls, for maintenance and deficiency.

There there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of two thousand two hundred and thirty-seven dollars and nine cents for deficiency (actual) for nineteen hundred and nine and nineteen hundred and ten.

That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of twenty-three thousand dollars for the Maine Industrial School for Girls, same to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of said school for maintenance and general expenses for nineteen hundred and twelve.

Approved March 29, 1911.

Chapter 154.

Resolve in favor of the clerk and stenographer to the Committee on Inland Fisheries and Game.

Resolved, that the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars be and is hereby appropriated to be paid to M. H. Hodgdon, of Augusta, Maine, for services as clerk and stenographer to the committee on inland fisheries and game during the present session.

Chapter 155.

Resolve in favor of Wilton Academy.

Resolved, that there be appropriated for the use of the trustees of Wilton Academy the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars for the purpose of completing the repairing and remodeling of the present school building, and for completing the installation of a heating plant.
