CHAP. 189

Chapter 189.

Resolve in favor of Wilbur F. Dresser, the Chairman of the Joint Special Committee on Portland Bridge for expenditures made in connection with hearing on Portland Bridge.

Wilbur F. Dresser, expenditures. **for**

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to Wilbur F. Dresser, the chairman of the joint special committee on Portland bridge, the sum of four hundred ninety-three dollars, for the following expenditures made by him in connection with the hearing before the joint special committee on Portland bridge, namely:

For services and expenses of Harold S. Boardman, expert witness, the sum of three hundred dollars.....	\$300 00
For services of Fred L. Hayden, stenographer at hearing and transcript of testimony, the sum of one hundred and eighty-three dollars	183 00
For expenses of Ira C. Foss and Howard Davies, the sum of ten dollars.....	10 00

Resolve in favor of Edward W. Wheeler.

Resolved, that the sum of three hundred and ninety-six dollars be and hereby is appropriated and paid to Edward W. Wheeler, chairman of the committee appointed by the seventy-fourth legislature to investigate the laws relating to organization of corporations, to defray expenses of said committee.

Resolve in favor of Chairman of Committee on Indian Affairs.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of forty dollars to be paid to W. Scott Kellogg, chairman, for expense of committee on trip to Old Town, January twenty-seven, and typewriting.
