Resolve in favor of clerk, stenographer and messenger to the Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of five hundred dollars to be paid to K. M. Dunbar for services as clerk to the committee on appropriations and financial affairs; one hundred dollars to be paid Louise Lewis for services as stenographer; fifty dollars to be paid Alonzo G. Dennis for services as messenger; eight dollars to be paid George W. Merrill for rental of type writer.

Chapter 208.

Resolve in favor of the Clerk, Stenographer and the Messenger to the Judiciary Committee.

Resolved, that there be appropriated and paid to Elisha W. Pike the sum of five hundred dollars for services as clerk to the judiciary committee, and that the sum of forty-eight dollars and seventy-three cents be paid to said clerk to reimburse him for the rental of typewriters, for postage stamps used by him in forwarding legislative notices, and telegraph and telephone expenses; and that there be appropriated and paid to Frances A. Baker the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars for services as stenographer to said committee; and that there be appropriated and paid to Foster Mansell the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars for services as messenger to said committee.
