Chapter 218.

Resolve in favor of John Bradbury.

Resolved, that there be paid to John Bradbury, of Fairfield, John Brada pension of four dollars per month, beginning with the first vor of. day of January, nineteen hundred and eleven, and continuing during the pleasure of the legislature and until otherwise ordered.

Approved March 31, 1911.

Chapter 219.

Resolve to appropriate a sum of money to pay clerical services of committee on Telegraphs and Telephones.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum J. M. Lane, in favor of. of fifty dollars to be paid J. M. Lane, for services as clerk to committee on telegraphs and telephones.

Approved March 31, 1911.

Chapter 220.

Resolve in favor of Cordelia Andrews of Oxford, widow of Freeman B. Andrews, a soldier in the Civil War.

Resolved, that a pension of four dollars per month be paid Cordella Anto Cordelia Andrews, widow of Freeman B. Andrews, late of drews, in favor of. Oxford, who was a soldier in the civil war.
