### **Chapter 218.**

Resolve in favor of John Bradbury.

Resolved, that there be paid to John Bradbury, of Fairfield, a pension of four dollars per month, beginning with the first day of January, nineteen hundred and eleven, and continuing during the pleasure of the legislature and until otherwise ordered.

### **Chapter 219.**

Resolve to appropriate a sum of money to pay clerical services of committee on Telegraphs and Telephones.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of fifty dollars to be paid J. M. Lane, for services as clerk to committee on telegraphs and telephones.

### **Chapter 220.**

Resolve in favor of Cordelia Andrews of Oxford, widow of Freeman B. Andrews, a soldier in the Civil War.

Resolved, that a pension of four dollars per month be paid to Cordelia Andrews, widow of Freeman B. Andrews, late of Oxford, who was a soldier in the civil war.
