Chapter 40.

CHAP. 40

An Act to Amend Section Twenty-three of Chapter Eighteen of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapter Twenty-six of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seven Relating to the State Laboratory of Hygiene.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty-three of chapter eighteen of the revised statutes, as amended by chapter twenty-six of the public laws of nineteen hundred and seven, is hereby further amended by striking out the words "four thousand five hundred" and substituting in the place thereof the words 'five thousand five hundred,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:

'Section 23. The sum of five thousand five hundred dollars a year is hereby appropriated to pay for the services of the director, and of such assistants as may be necessary, to procure the necessary supplies, and to meet the other necessary expenses of said laboratory, which sum shall be expended under the supervision of the state board of health.'

Section 23, of chapter 18, R. S., as amended by chapter 26, P. L. of 1907, further amended.

Five thousand five hundred dollars appropriated for salaries, etc.

Approved March 12, 1913.

Chapter 41.

An Act to Repeal Chapter One Hundred Fifty-three of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Eleven, Entitled "An Act to Prohibit the Use of Gang Hooks, so-called, when Fishing in the Inland Waters of this State."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter one hundred fifty-three of the public laws of nineteen hundred eleven, entitled "An Act to prohibit the use of gang hooks, so-called, when fishing in the inland waters of this state," is hereby repealed.

Chapter 53, P. L. of 1911, repealed.

Approved March 12, 1913.

Chapter 42.

An Act to Amend Sections Eighty and Eighty-one of Chapter Fifty-two of the Revised Statutes Relating to Provisions for Safety in the Management and Operation of Steam Railroads.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section eighty of chapter fifty-two of the revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word "manner" in the first line the words 'or drinks intoxicating liquors as a beverage,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

Section 80 of chapter 52, R. S., amended.
