**Chapter 199.**

CHAP. 199

An Act Providing Temporary Clerk Hire for the Register of Deeds in Penobscot County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

In addition to any sums now provided by law, there shall be paid the register of deeds in Penobscot county the sum of six hundred dollars per year for clerk hire for two years beginning July first, nineteen hundred thirteen, said sum to be paid from the county treasury.

**Chapter 200.**

An Act Providing Temporary Clerk Hire for the Clerk of Courts in Cumberland County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

In addition to any sums now provided by law, there shall be paid the clerk of courts in Cumberland county the sum of six hundred dollars per year for clerk hire for two years beginning July first, nineteen hundred thirteen, said sum to be paid from the county treasury.

**Chapter 201.**

An Act Providing Temporary Clerk Hire for the Clerk of Courts in Piscataquis County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

In addition to any sums now provided by law, there shall be paid the clerk of courts in Piscataquis county the sum of two hundred dollars per year for two years beginning July first, nineteen hundred thirteen, said sum to be paid from the county treasury.
