Chapter 236.

An Act to Appropriate Moneys for the Expenditures of the Government for the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Expenditures of government, in part, for 1913.

Section 1. In order to provide for the several acts and resolves of the legislature requiring the payment of money from the state treasury, and also to provide in part for the necessary expenditures of government for the current fiscal year one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, the following sums are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury, and, except where otherwise specially provided, the governor with the advice and consent of the council, is hereby authorized at any time prior to the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and fourteen, to draw his warrant on the state treasurer for the same.

Chapter 237.

An Act to Appropriate Moneys for the Expenditures of Government and to Provide for Payment of Certain Deficiencies Remaining Unpaid January First, One Thousand Nine Hundred and Thirteen.

Whereas, the various deficiency items comprised in this act are long overdue and further delay in the payment thereof will occasion great inconvenience to many departments of the state government and to citizens of the state; and whereas in the opinion of this legislature these facts constitute this act an emergency measure, which is immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, now therefore, Preamble.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. In order to provide for the payment of the several claims, accounts and demands against the state, accrued prior to, and remaining unpaid on January first, one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, by reason of no appropriations or insufficient appropriations, the following sums are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury, and, except where otherwise specially provided, the governor with the advice and
