**Chapter 243.**

An Act to Appropriate Moneys for the Expenditures of Government for the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fourteen.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. In order to provide for the several acts and resolves of the legislature requiring the payment of money from the state treasurer, and also to provide for the necessary expenditures of government for the current fiscal year one thousand nine hundred fourteen, the following sums are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury, and except on accounts closed December thirty-first, nineteen hundred and fourteen, (which shall not include state institutions), and except where otherwise specially provided by law, the governor

Expenditures of government for 1914.

CHAP. 243 with the advice and consent of the council, is hereby authorized at any time prior to the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, to draw his warrant on the state treasurer for the same.
