Chapter 29.

CHAP. 29

Resolve, in Favor of C. R. Hall and George S. Lowell.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated, to be paid to C. R. Hall of Wilton and George S. Lowell of Farmington the sum of sixty dollars on account of loss and damage on cattle held by quarantine.

Chapter 30.

Resolve, for Aid of Navigation on Lewys, Long and Big Lakes in Washington County.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sums of one hundred and fifty dollars in nineteen hundred and thirteen and fifty dollars in nineteen hundred and fourteen for placing buoys in Lewys, Long and Big Lakes, and for the aid of navigation on said lakes one hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and thirteen and fifty dollars in nineteen hundred and fourteen. Said buoys shall be placed at such points in said lakes as will best serve the needs of navigation thereon.

Navigation on Lewys, Long and Big Lakes in aid of.

All said moneys shall be expended under the direction of the state steamboat inspectors.

Any part of the money hereby appropriated which shall be unexpended at the end of the years nineteen hundred and thirteen-nineteen hundred and fourteen shall revert to the State.

Chapter 31.

Resolve, in Favor of the Machiasport and East Machias Bridge.

Resolved, that there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1000) for the year nineteen hundred and thirteen, only, for the purpose of completing and protecting the Machiasport and East Machias bridge; said appropriation to be expended under the direction of the State Highway Department.

Chapter 32.

Resolve, in Favor of the Town of Roque Bluffs.

Resolved, that there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) to aid the town of Roque Bluffs in reconstructing a bridge across Marsh River, provided

CHAP. 33 that said town of Roque Bluffs shall raise and appropriate Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) for the same purpose; both sums to be expended under the direction of the State Highway Department.

Chapter 33.

Resolve, in Favor of Aid in Building a Highway Bridge Across Moose River, in Jackman Plantation in the County of Somerset.

Resolved, that the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4000) be, and hereby is, appropriated to aid in building a highway bridge across Moose River in the plantation of Jackman, in the county of Somerset, subject to the following provisions:

That the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2000) shall be raised by the county of Somerset and two thousand dollars (\$2000) shall be raised by the plantations of Jackman, Dennistown and Moose River, in said county of Somerset; said two thousand dollars (\$2000) to be raised in the plantations of Jackman, Dennistown and Moose River to be apportioned among said plantations according to their respective valuations; and said county of Somerset and said plantations of Jackman, Dennistown and Moose River are hereby authorized and required to raise the sums herein provided, for them to raise, by loan, taxation, or otherwise.

Provided, also, that abutments of said bridge shall be constructed of concrete; and the superstructure of steel, which shall be eighteen feet wide, exclusive of a sidewalk, which shall be placed upon one side only of said bridge.

Provided, also, that the location and erection of said bridge shall be made by the county commissioners of Somerset County under the supervision of the State Highway Department.

Chapter 34.

Resolve, in Favor of the Town of Whiting.

Resolved, that there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500) to be paid to the town of Whiting in Washington County, to reimburse it for cost of repairs to the bridge across Holmes Stream in said town of Whiting.
