CHAP. 42

Resolve, in Favor of the City of Biddeford.

Biddeford,

Resolved, that the sum of five hundred and seventy dollars and seventeen cents, be and is hereby appropriated, to be paid by the Treasurer of State to the city of Biddeford out of moneys of the state not otherwise appropriated, for money expended by the city of Biddeford for the care and support of Joseph Labelle, a state insane pauper, and said sum shall be paid only on vouchers produced by said city of Biddeford, and approved by the Governor and Council.

Resolve, in Favor of the City of Biddeford.

Resolved, that the sum of five hundred and ninety-one dollars and eighty-two cents be, and the same is hereby appropriated, to be paid by the treasurer of state to the city of Biddeford out of moneys of the state, not otherwise appropriated, for money expended by the city of Biddeford for the care and support of Joseph Taillon, a state insane pauper, and said sum shall be paid only on vouchers, produced by said city of Biddeford and approved by the Governor and Council.
