Chapter 58.

CHAP. 58

Resolve, in Favor of Repairing the Bridge Across the Kennebec River
Between the Plantations of West Forks and The Forks.

Resolved, that there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of six hundred dollars (\$600) to aid in the repair of the bridge across the Kennebec River, between the plantations of West Forks and The Forks, in Somerset County, provided the County of Somerset appropriates the like sum of six hundred dollars (\$600) for the same purpose; both sums to be expended by the county commissioners of Somerset County under the supervision of the State Highway Department.

Chapter 59.

Resolve, in Favor of Repair of Covered Bridge Across the Kennebec
River in the Town of Norridgewock.

Resolved, that there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1500) for the year 1914, to aid the town of Norridgewock in the repair of the covered bridge across the Kennebec river, in the town of Norridgewock, provided said town of Norridgewock appropriates the like sum of fifteen hundred dollars (\$1500) for the same purpose; both sums to be expended under the direction of the State Highway Department.

Chapter 60.

Resolve, for the Appointment of Delegates to the Conferences of the
National Tax Association.

Resolved, that the governor, by and with the consent of the council, be and hereby is authorized and empowered to appoint not more than three delegates to represent the state of Maine at any conferences of the National Tax Association which may be held during the years nineteen hundred and thirteen and nineteen hundred and fourteen. Such delegates shall serve without compensation, but their actual expenses as allowed by the governor and council shall be paid from the state treasury.
