Chapter 120.

CHAP. 120

Resolve, in Aid of Repairing a Highway in the Town of Benton.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2000) in the year nineteen hundred thirteen and two thousand dollars (\$2000) in the year nineteen hundred fourteen to aid in rebuilding the "Neck Road," so-called, in the town of Benton; provided there be appropriated by the town of Benton, or otherwise, the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2000) in the year nineteen hundred thirteen and two thousand dollars (\$2000) in the year nineteen hundred fourteen for the same purpose; both sums to be expended under the supervision of the state highway department.

Chapter 121.

Resolve, in Aid of Repairing the Highways in the Town of Trescott.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) in the year nineteen hundred thirteen, and two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250) in the year nineteen hundred fourteen for the purpose of repairing the highways in the town of Trescott in Washington County; both sums to be expended under the supervision of the state highway department.

Chapter 122.

Resolve, for the Permanent Improvement and Repair of "The New Kenduskeag Road" in the Town of Glenburn.

Resolved, that the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) be and is hereby appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and thirteen from any unexpended balance now in the state treasury, for the permanent improvement and repair of "The New Kenduskeag Road" in the town of Glenburn in Penobscot County, to be expended under the supervision of the state highway department.
