Chapter 127.

Resolve, in Favor of the Western State Normal School for the Purchase of Equipment for the Manual Training Department.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated in favor of the Western State Normal School at Gorham the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred thirteen, and the sum of two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fourteen; both said amounts to be expended under the direction of the trustees of the state normal schools for the purchase of equipment for the manual training department.

Chapter 128.

Resolve, for Aid in Repairing the "Pond" Road, So Called, in the Town of Readfield.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) for the purpose of repairing the "Pond" road, so called, connecting the Kent's Hill road with the Mount Vernon road, in the town of Readfield; provided that the town of Readfield appropriates the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) for the same purpose; both sums to be expended under the direction of the state highway department.

Chapter 129.

Resolve, in Aid of Rebuilding the Lower Bridge, So Called, Across the Mattawamkeag River in Moro Plantation.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2500) to aid in rebuilding the lower bridge, so-called, in Moro plantation, in the county of Aroostook, provided that there be raised and appropriated
