Farmington State Normal School in favor of equipment, etc. amount to be expended under the direction of the board of trustees of the state normal schools, for furnishings and equipment for a dormitory at said school; provided, however, that said board of trustees may, at the discretion of the board, apply any of said amount toward purposes of construction.

Chapter 137.

Resolve, in Favor of the City of Saco for Money Expended in the Investigation of Incendiary Fires.

Saco, city of, in favor of.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated seventy-five dollars (\$75) to reimburse the city of Saco for expenses incurred in the investigation of incendiary fires.

Chapter 138.

Resolve for Aid in Building a Highway Bridge Across Crooked River Between the Towns of Casco and Naples, in the County of Cumberland.

Bridge across Crooked river, In aid of building of. Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3000) to aid in the construction of a bridge across Crooked river between the towns of Casco and Naples, in the county of Cumberland, provided, that there be appropriated by said towns of Casco and Naples or otherwise, the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2000) for the same purpose; both sums to be expended under the supervision of the state highway department.

Chapter 139.

Resolve, Relating to the Publication of "The Beginnings of Colonial Maine."

Beginnings of Colonial Maine, in favor of publication of. Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred thirteen, and five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred fourteen, to be expended under the direction of the governor and council, by the state historian for the purpose of defraying the expenses, in part, for the publication of "The Beginnings of Colonial Maine."
