Chapter 138.

Resolve for Aid in Building a Highway Bridge Across Crooked River Between the Towns of Casco and Naples, in the County of Cumberland.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of three thousand dollars (\$3000) to aid in the construction of a bridge across Crooked river between the towns of Casco and Naples, in the county of Cumberland, provided, that there be appropriated by said towns of Casco and Naples or otherwise, the sum of two thousand dollars (\$2000) for the same purpose; both sums to be expended under the supervision of the state highway department.
