CHAP. 156**Chapter 156.**

Resolve, for Aid in Building a Highway Bridge in the Plantation of New Canada.

bridge in.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) to aid in the construction of a bridge across Perley brook, so called, in the plantation of New Canada, on the road leading from Fort Kent to Caribou, in the plantation of New Canada, provided there be appropriated by the plantation of New Canada, or otherwise, the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500) for the same purpose; both sums to be expended under the supervision of the state highway department.

Approved March 18, 1913.

Chapter 157.

Resolve, for Aid in Building a Bridge Across the Umcolcus Stream in Oxbow Plantation in Aroostook County.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of twelve hundred dollars (\$1200) to aid in constructing a bridge across the Umcolcus stream in Oxbow plantation, in the county of Aroostook; provided there be appropriated by Oxbow plantation, in the county of Aroostook, or otherwise, the sum of twelve hundred dollars (\$1200) for the same purpose; both sums to be expended under the supervision of the state highway department.

Chapter 158.

Resolve, in Aid of Building a Bridge Across Sandy Stream in the Plantation of Lexington.

building
bridge in.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) to aid in the building of a bridge across Sandy stream on the "East" road, so called, in the plantation of Lexington and the county of Somerset, provided there be appropriated by said plantation of Lexington or otherwise the sum of one thousand dollars (\$1000) for the same purpose; both sums to be expended under the supervision of the state highway department.
