CHAP. 162**Chapter 162.**

Resolve, Providing a State Pension for James R. Hunton.

Hunton,
James R., to
provide
state pen-
sion for.

Resolved, that there be paid to James R. Hunton, of Milford, a pension of eight dollars per month, beginning with the first day of January, nineteen hundred and thirteen, and continuing during the pleasure of the legislature, and until otherwise ordered.

Chapter 163.

Resolve, in Aid of Navigation on Rangeley Lake, Mooselucmeguntic Lake and Cupsuptic Lake.

Rangeley
lakes, in aid

tion on.

Resolved, that the sum of four hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for removing obstructions and for placing buoys in Rangeley lake, Mooselucmeguntic lake and Cupsuptic lake and for the erection of lights in Rangeley lake, Mooselucmeguntic lake and Cupsuptic lake and the maintenance of the same for the year nineteen hundred and thirteen, and a like sum for the year nineteen hundred and fourteen for the same purposes. Said buoys and lights shall be placed at such points in said lakes as will best serve the needs of navigation thereon. All said moneys shall be expended under the direction of the state steamboat inspectors. Any part of the money hereby appropriated for removing obstructions, for the placing of buoys and lights and maintenance of lights which shall be unexpended at the end of the year nineteen hundred and fourteen shall revert to the state.

Chapter 164.

Resolve, for Aid in Building a Bridge Across Moose River Near Its Mouth.

Moose river,
in favor of
bridge
across.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) to aid in building a bridge across Moose river near its mouth, in the township of Rockwood, provided that the Great Northern Paper Company shall appropriate four thousand dollars (\$4,000) for the same purpose. The location of said bridge shall be determined by, and the expenditure of both sums of money, shall be under the supervision of the state highway department.
